



Arco COVID-19 safety plan

Updated 9 April 2021

Return to in-person lessons per 24 April 2021.

At our lessons and venue:

- Each participant must wash their hands and/or use hand sanitiser before and after the lesson. Hand sanitiser will be provided.
- All adults must wear face masks indoors, unless you are exempt. Please carry your exemption card at all times.
- Max. 15 people allowed in the room. Parents/carers must only attend when there is need for the child to do so.
- One way system for entrance and exit will be maintained:
 1. Enter through main entrance
 2. Arrive max 15 minutes before the lesson start, wait downstairs
 3. Children will be collected by a member of Arco, at the start time of their lesson
 4. Parents will leave through the back door of the building
 5. For collection: arrive max 15 minutes before the end of the lesson, wait downstairs, a member of Arco will bring all children safely back down.
 6. Immediately leave through back door of the building. In the current climate we can not stay at Lift for a social gathering.
- Maintain 2 meter distance at all times, floor will be clearly marked for children's positions.
- Seating will be wiped before each lesson.
- Instruments and other material cannot be shared amongst pupils.
- Following the government's guidelines: Singing is allowed, all singers should face forward and be socially distanced.
- Windows will be open to allow sufficient ventilation: bring a jumper!
- New instruments will be thoroughly cleaned and handed out after a resting period of minimum 72 hours. Based on research suggesting COVID-19 can remain on string instruments for up to 3 days.

At home:

- Stay home when you show symptoms of COVID-19.
- Wash hands before and after playing your violin.
- Do not clean the violin or bow at home, if you want it cleaned, this can be done with the appropriate products by team Arco.
